Conference Objective

The Eighth International Conference on *Digital Presentation and Preservation of Cultural and Scientific Heritage—DiPP2018* aims at presenting innovative results, research projects and applications in the field of digitisation, documentation, archiving, representation and preservation of global and national tangible and intangible cultural and scientific heritage. The focus is on providing open access to digitised cultural heritage and setting up sustainable policies for its continuous digital preservation and conservation. The priority area is the digital presentation and preservation of cultural and historical objects under conditions of risk, including those from the Burgas region. The forum will demonstrate innovative technologies and proto-types which result from established practices and achievements in the field. Representatives from a number of public and specialised libraries, museums, galleries, archives, centres, and national as well as foreign research institutions and universities will be invited to participate and exchange experiences, ideas, knowledge and best practices of the field.
